I. Critical Writing

GRADES 5-8

Course Description:

Students work with instructors to develop essays to submit to both national and international writing contests (sponsored by the National Academy of Engineering, the Goi Peace Foundation, and more!). For each essay draft, instructors will provide helpful feedback and instructions for improvement.

Course Objective:

Our instructors guide students to develop well-researched, thoughtful, and organized responses to essay contest

prompts while improving writing mechanics.

Class Frequency:

1.5 hours/week (1 essay contest is covered every 5 classes)

II. Literacy and Leadership Building (Online or In-person)

GRADES 2-8

Course Description:

Developed to help fill in gaps in education due to the COVID-19 pandemic, this program covers both leadership topics (social awareness, habits, and public speaking) and academics (vocabulary, grammar, and critical analysis).

Course Objective:

Students will improve in the areas of writing, confidence, resilience, and habits to help unlock and grow their full

potential.

Class Frequency:

1.5 hours/week (1 leadership topic covered every 4 classes)

III. 1:1 Tutoring (Online or In-person)

ALL GRADES

Course Description: One-on-one tutoring offers individualized, concentrated instruction in the four core subjects: English (writing,

grammar, reading), math and science.

This is the only course where online learning is an option

Course Objective: 1:1 tutoring is recommended for students who need to make significant improvement in one specific subject.

Class Frequency: 1.5 hours per week minimum for each subject

(dependent upon student needs)

Tuition: \$25/hour (Elementary School), \$35/hour (Middle School), \$45/hour (High School)

IV. GPA Management

GRADES 7-12

Course Description: Academic mentoring program for students who need a boost in more than one subject. Instructors provide

personalized check-in's and guidance on concepts students struggle with. In addition, we provide repetitive practice and focused study necessary to prepare for tests (including AP exams and Regents) and quizzes given in school.

Course Objective: GPA Management was developed to help students boost their overall GPA in school. Last year, students improved

their grades in the core subjects from mid 80's to mid 90's.

Class Frequency: 3 hours/week MINIMUM (students may come for additional hours each week for extra help)

Tuition: \$300/4 weeks
